READ TALK PLAY EVERY DAY

Expanded the Read Talk Play initiative from American Falls to Bannock County. Added 20 new partners throughout SE Idaho for the Read Talk Play Initiative.

GRANTS TO LOCAL

NONPROFITS

PRESCHOOL INITIATIVES

- Awarded \$46,000 in preschool scholarships; expanding educational opportunities to 62 students; leading to an additional 4% increase in school readiness scores.
- Hosted 2nd Annual Provider Reception with 70 preschool and daycare providers in attendance.

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

- Brought our TMC Lab to engage 728 school-aged youth in STEM activities.
- Partnered with school districts on family engagement activities/events for 1,403 children and their families.



TEAMING UP FOR TOMORROW

Increased 15% in giving, which resulted in more than \$486,000 invested into our local network of nonprofits that provided basic needs, increased economic mobility and helped continue to break the cycle of poverty in our community.

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND

The Community Fund dollars raised over the last year during our Teaming up for Tomorrow campaign - a total of \$327,350 in Community Fund grants - were awarded to 26 vetted and trusted local nonprofit programs that help stabilize ALICE households.

RIDE UNITED

Launched Ride United, a first-of-its-kind initiative in Idaho that provides free transportation for health-related activities for community members in need who are patients of our local free clinic, crisis and recovery centers,

and mental health providers.



GET HEALTHY IDAHO

Conducted a community health needs assessment in Bannock County to determine barriers to health and found that our community's ALICE families experience the following unmet needs: Housing (29.4%), food (28.4), utilities (22%), and transportation (21.1%).
